Dear Homeowners,

West Shore Park Corporation (WSPC) has recently been made aware that there are fire pits on WSPC Community Property. Due to safety and health concerns, potential insurance liabilities and aesthetics, fire pits and fires are prohibited on Community Property in WSPC's Rules and Regulations. We respectfully ask that WSPC members please do not burn or use fire pits on WSPC property.

Regarding Open Burning on private property, the following information is from the Countryside Fire Department web site - <http://www.countrysidefire.com/general/open-burning-regulations/>

Please notify Countryside Dispatch (non-emergency) at (847) 918-6110 before doing any burning.

Burning of leaves and small branches is permitted during daylight hours. Open burning must be 25' from any structure and 50' from schools and roads. Absolutely no burning on roads. The burning of landscape waste must be generated on the property. Maximum size of any burn pile is 5' in diameter and 3' high.

It is the focus of this board to keep the common property aesthetically pleasing and most importantly keep all WSPC members and property **safe**. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact any WSPC Director.
